



#### **Community Service WIG STAND update**


Over 50 wig stands and hats have been delivered! Our partners are Wigs for the Cure in Mora MN and EBeauty Community in metro area.




#### **Beads At Home**
















# Next Meeting – October 5






Jim Walker brought his output of segmented Christmas ornaments. He described his quick production method, which the other attendees could barely believe.
